

The underlying theme for CSA has evolved to engage the audience in empowering and encouraging women in sports.





The spatial design will reflect femininity and fluidity, by using soft organic curves inspired by the ribbon.





Graphic Treatment

A new form of treatment has been crafted to compliment and enhance the instantly recognisable CSA brand. Together, the CSA pattern and new circular formation strengthens the brand and highlights the concept of progression, fluidity and movement.

The solid line gives these forms a 'frame' in which to grow. These lines can be seen as key words, new shapes and become on-site branding and supporting assets.



Graphic Treatment

Combining the existing branding and the new concept in a soft and desaturated style, creates a treatment that is subtle yet dynamic. It can be used to accent and lift the spatial design, content and graphics.



Experience

The guest experience begins in the pre function, an open, yet visually stimulating space for socialising. The main awards take place on a sensational stage; the focal point of the experience, where excitement, celebration and recognition are at the heart.

Pre-function


An area to gather before the main event that shares the overall design direction. This features a Majlis, meeting areas and media features.



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



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Stage Scenography






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

Objective






Act One - Global Talent - The Stories
